

Neo-Nazi Kurdish Hawpa Group Threatens to Exterminate Assyrians

Introduction

In 2020, a Kurdish political group called Hawpa was established in the northern Iraq region that is under Kurdish autonomy. In Sorani Kurdish, Hawpa is literally 'accomplice or person of same type'. In Kurmanji Kurdish is also known as *Kurdish National Socialist organization* or "**PSNK**", which is a Kurdish neo-Nazi movement.

Hawpa was established on the first day of Nowruz 2020. Through various on-line platforms such as Instagram and Telegram, Hawpa has undertaken a campaign to promote **their belief that Arabs should be expelled from the Kurdistan Region, while Turkomen and Assyrians/Chaldeans/Aramean-Syriacs should be genocided**. Furthermore, Hawpa has engaged in activism by displaying posters all around Kurdistan.

Iconography

In the majority Kurdish regions, there are many ancient historical finds that show the Hawpa swastika as a very old symbol. The symbol is a simple geometric pattern consisting of a cross with four arms, all of the same length. Each arm of the swastika is bent at a right angle, and the ends of the arms are also curved.

Ideology

Hawpa's ideology has its origins in the Hiwa Party (1939-1946) and the Kajik Party (1959-1975), which were founded on the basis of fascist and Nazi ideas. In addition, the ideology also refers to former Kurdish politicians and figures such as Ramzi Nafi Agha and Rafiq Hilmi, who were regarded as fascists and collaborated with Nazi Germany. But the Hawpa also draws on contemporary writers such as Hama Mirwaisi and Samar Abbas. Hawpaism rejects the modern intellectualism of the Kurdish Populace, since the ideology holds that today's intellectuals in Kurdistan are nihilists and leftists.

[Hawpa is a] Fascist party that bases its policies, both economic and social, on the philosophy of Giovanni Gentile and follows in the footsteps of an Anti-Communist and Anti-Capitalist Nationalistic movement which advocates corporatism and the unifications of our people as one cohesive block, based on culture and the regional territories we inhabit and have inhabited for centuries.—Hawpa Manifesto

The Assyrians

The Assyrians are a Semitic nation that speaks Syriac as their native language. They live in southern, northern, eastern, western Kurdistan and Iraq, most of whom live in the United States. According to sources, the number of Assyrians is 2 to 4 million, but this figure is an exaggeration, because the presence of Assyrians in the world is not so much, because the Assyrians are a new nation and not old. There are less than 100,000 in Kurdistan. How can they become 4 million? There are 2 million worldwide, but 3 to 4 million is an incorrect figure

History

The history of the Assyrians does not go back to BC. If we look at the real history of this people, we know that they have nothing to do with the ancient Assyrians, but a nation that appeared in the 18th and 19th centuries. If we look at the history of the ancient Assyrians, after the fall of Nineveh in 612 BC, no kingdom or state or village was ruled by this people. The history of the Assyrians is very vague. There is an opinion that these people were Jews and then became Christians, which may be due to the priests and orientalist who came to Kurdistan and worked on this people and created a fabricated identity. In the early 20th century, the Assyrians emerged as a political force in the region, playing a role in the chaos of the collapse of the Ottoman Empire as men and subordinates of the British, Russians and Armenians East Kurdistan, where Samko Shakak did no harm to himself and his people, but allowed them to settle temporarily, but the Assyrians had bad intentions against the Kurds and began to gather forces. Their first attack was on the Harki tribe on the southern and eastern borders They looted the Harki tribe in the area, and then they became the guardians of the Russian army in its attacks on Urmia and the areas under the rule of Samko Shakak. In the meantime, many Kurds were martyred and their property was looted They attacked and occupied Rawanduz. In 1915, the Kurds of Rawanduz began to be killed and looted. After the Bolshevik Revolution in Russia, the Assyrians were left without a refuge in the Middle East. The Kurds, led by Samko Shakak, began attacking the Assyrian-controlled areas 1918, cleanse the Assyrian tribes and remnants from the region and restore freedom to Urmia. In this incident, the Assyrians sought refuge with the British, who had just occupied the province of Mosul. The British planned to settle the Assyrian tribes in Kurdistan and created a special mercenary force for them, called Levi. In 1924, the Assyrians plundered the Kurds of Kirkuk, which prompted King Mahmoud to issue a fatwa of jihad against the Assyrians When Mahmud did not gain strength, they began to attack Sulaymaniyah with the Levi forces, thus ending the Kurdistan Kingdom. The British Foreign Office planned to create a region for the Assyrians, but could not implement this plan due to demographic and political reasons in the region. This caused the Assyrians to settle in southern Kurdistan (Kirkuk, Erbil and Duhok). The history of the Assyrians began and continues in this way. The arrival of the Assyrians in the south of the country dates back to 100 years ago.

What is the goal of the Assyrians?

The Assyrians have always tried to create a state or region on Kurdistan. This Zionist goal is in the minds of every Assyrian, regardless of regional and cultural background Marshamoun tried to achieve independence with the help of the Russians, but Samko Shakak frustrated that dream. In 1933, the Assyrians in the Simele region began to revolt to create an Assyrian region in the region The reason for the repetition of the Palestinian-Israeli scenario, but this time we are Palestinians and they are Israelis, this dream was frustrated by another Kurdish hero, Bakr Sadqi Christians, the Assyrians eagerly resumed the old policy, this time not a policy of hostility, this time a policy of coexistence and weakening the Kurdish people. Today, the Assyrians, led by Mar Bashar, who appear to the world in the name of Christianity and religious minorities, but hide their faces behind their crosses, appear to be humanitarians,

but in fact they are not. Why are they lobbying against the Kurdistan Region? We must know that no matter how good we are with the Assyrians, no matter how brotherly we talk to them, they will not change their hearts. The goal of the Assyrians is to create a state, brotherhood with these is a dream.

In addition, they have many other maps that they consider their own and all of their maps are built on Kurdistan territory. Just as the Jews drew the plans and maps of Israel before World War I, the Assyrians are now drawing their own plans and maps.

How can the Kurds resist the establishment of the Assyrian state?

It is wrong to say that the Assyrians are a minority and can do nothing. Yes, the Jews were a minority and gained their own state. The Armenians were a minority compared to the Kurds and Azeris in Karabakh, but they gained their own state. The first thing the Kurds must do is not to underestimate the enemy. The following preparations must be made to prevent the Assyrian threat to the Kurds:

1. Creating a lobby: The Kurds should start creating a lobby against the Assyrians and the Assyrian lobby abroad. This counter-lobby is the best tool to prevent the plan of the Assyrian state from taking place.

1. It is an obstacle to the Assyrian plan.
2. It will attract the support of countries to the Kurds.
- 3- Integration of Kurds abroad.
4. Creating a lobby against Kurdish enemies.

Unfortunately, the Assyrians are the few nations that lobby abroad better than the Kurds.

2. Dissolution of Assyrian organizations and parties: This step is the most important and best step for the Kurdish cause in the south and prevent further division of Kurdistan. The Assyrian parties and organizations are always trying to gather the masses and bring Assyrians abroad to South Kurdistan and view the Kurdistan Region as a hostile observer.

1. Ends the plan of the Assyrian state.
2. The internal affairs of the Kurdistan Region will become more stable.
3. It will prevent any future Assyrian uprising.
4. Weakening the hegemony of countries in the region.

3- Preventing Assyrian cultural activities: The Assyrians take Kurdish culture and sell it to us. Theft of Kurdish culture is not only by the Turks and Persians, but also by the Assyrians This is, of course, the first and smallest step to eradicate plagiarism.

4. Dissolution of the Assyrian militias: The forces of the governor of Nineveh, belonging to the Assyrian Democratic Movement, are deployed in the Nineveh region against the Peshmerga forces, along with Iraqi and Iranian militias. These forces will attack the Kurdistan Region whenever the situation in Kurdistan deteriorates.

1. The threat of Assyrian attack from Nineveh to the Kurdistan Region will disappear.
2. Disarm the Assyrians and protect the future of Kurdistan.
3. Reduce the process of Arabization in Nineveh and its Kurdish areas.
4. Weakening of the Assyrian front in any attempt to create an Assyrian state.

There are many other ways that can be taken against this great threat to the future of the region and the Kurds. If the Kurds do not remove this threat to their future, there is no doubt that they will not have a good future First, cleanse Kurdistan and then start removing foreign hegemony and forces. Do not waste the blood of the martyrs and think about the future of Kurdistan.

The question is, why would the KRG approve the creation of a Neo-Nazi Kurdish group that calls for the extermination of the Assyrian people in the Kurdish region?
